III. Summary of WYMX-FM/WBZL-FM/WTCD-FM Outreach/Recruitment Efforts- 02/01/2014-01/31/2015

Category: Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions:

During this reporting period, employees of licensee, Telesouth Communications, Inc. participated in three job fairs. We had at least one employee with hiring decision responsibility at each of the following Job Fairs:

1/30/2014 Employ Ability Job Fair. This job fair is designed to promote the hiring of Mississippians with disabilities. The fair was held in the Sparkman Building of the MS Ag and Forestry Museum and was hosted by the Governor's Job Fair Network. Camie Crowe who coordinates and manages interns for TeleSouth owned stations attended and met at least 10 possible candidates for future internships. (this job fair was omitted from last year's report)

3/19/2014 Mississippi Employment Expo---This expo was held at the Mississippi Trade Mart in Jackson, MS and was sponsored by the Governor's Job Fair Network and the Mississippi Department of Employment Security. In addition to sponsoring a booth, our station broadcasted live from this event. All Telesouth owned stations were represented by Bambi Wallace, Sales Manager of WFMN-FM in Jackson, MS.

3/20/2014 East Central Community College Business, Education and Healthcare Expo. This career fair was held on the Decatur, MS ECCC Campus in the Brackeen-Wood Physical Education Building. This event was designed to help students begin their careers and also encourages the general public to attend. Wanda Harrison, General Manager of WZKR in Meridian, MS represented all TeleSouth owned stations at this event.

Category: Participation in at least four events sponsored by organizations representing groups present in the community interested in broadcast employment issues, including conventions, career days, workshops and similar activities:

During this reporting period, employees of TeleSouth Communications, Inc., participated in two career fairs and represented all company-owned stations at these events.

3/4/2014: News Director Chris Davis attended Mississippi Association of Broadcaster's Day on Campus/ Career Day at the University of Mississippi. In addition to spending the day with Communication majors, Chris was selected to be part of a Q&A Panel where students were able to ask questions about careers in broadcasting.

3/19/2014: Corporate Sales Director Larry Tate attended the University of Mississippi's Career Day. Sponsored by the School of Mass Communication and Journalism, this event provides an opportunity for radio and television students to present their resumes and speak to media representatives from across Mississippi regarding job opportunities, what media professionals are looking for and how to prepare for a career in media.

Category: Establishing an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment:

During the reporting period, TeleSouth Communications, Inc. had two students participate in our internship program. One was from the University of Southern Mississippi and is a Broadcast Journalism major. The other was a high school student interested in a career in journalism.
