# III. Summary of WFMN-FM Outreach/Recruitment Efforts-02/01/2013-01/31/2014

## <u>Category: Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have</u> substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions:

During this reporting period, employees of Telesouth Communications, Inc., parent company of Licensee WFMN Inc., participated in two job fairs. We had at least one employee with hiring decision responsibility at each of the following Job Fairs:

<u>3/06/2013</u> University of Southern Mississippi- This Journalism Career and Internship Fair was held in the Thad Cochran Center on the campus of the University of Southern Mississippi. This event was organized by the School of Mass Communication and Journalism. Bob Ghetti, General Manager of WFMM in Hattiesburg, represented all company owned stations at this event.

3/20/2013 Mississippi Employment Expo---This Expo was held at the Mississippi Trade Mart in Jackson, MS and was sponsored by the Office of the Governor, Mississippi Development Authority and the Mississippi Department of Employment Security. In addition to sponsoring a booth, our station broadcasted live from this event. All Telesouth (parent company of Licensee WFMN Inc.) stations were represented by Joe Buckner, Director of Special Events.

<u>Category: Participation in at least four events sponsored by organizations</u>
<u>representing groups present in the community interested in broadcast employment issues, including conventions, career days, workshops and similar activities:</u>

During this reporting period, employees of TeleSouth Communications, Inc., parent company of Licensee WFMN Inc., participated in three career fairs and represented all company-owned stations at this event. All events were sponsored by the Mississippi Association of Broadcasters.

3/5/2013: WQLJ-FM/WTNM-FM General Manager Rick Mize attended MAB Day on Campus/ Career Day at the University of Mississippi. Rick was selected to speak to a group of students who were interested in careers in radio broadcasting.

9/27/2013: News Director Chris Davis and Program Director David Day visited Jackson State University's e-Center for MAB on Campus to meet with students from Jackson Metro-area colleges about broadcast careers. The two spent the morning session meeting with students and critiquing their tapes. After lunch, Davis and Day participated in a panel discussion about the integration of new media into the daily duties of broadcasters and the vital part new media plays in broadcast companies.

<u>10/18/2013</u>: The men traveled to Mississippi State University in Starkville for another MAB on Campus session. The format was much the same as the September 27<sup>th</sup> event in Jackson. Before lunch were sessions with students and critiques. After lunch was a panel

discussion about the broadcast news field in general. Day and Davis were both picked for the panel and entertained questions from students.

During the reporting period, TeleSouth Communications, Inc., parent company of Licensee WFMN Inc., had six students participate in our internship program. Three were from Mississippi College, Two from Tougaloo College, and One from the University of Southern Mississippi. These students had the opportunity to rotate and spend time participating in all areas of broadcasting operations. These internships were unpaid and class credit was given to each participant.
